

GENERAL INFORMATION

CAPITOL INFORMATION: There is an excellent view of the city from the 22nd floor of the Capitol. There is a Chapel on the Plaza Level (1st floor) of the Capitol, as well as a gift shop, the Visitor's Center, and bathrooms. There are passages on the 2nd and 3rd floors to travel from the Capitol building to the House or Senate Office Buildings. From Monroe, the House Office Building is on the right, and the Senate Office Building is on the left.

OBTAINING CALENDARS, JOURNALS, AND BILLS: Copies of House bills, calendars, and journals are available from the Documents Office in Room 334 of the Capitol. Senate bills, calendars, and journals are available from Senate Distribution in Room 304 of the Capitol. Agendas, committee member lists, bill summaries, and committee meetings are contained in the Calendar.

PARKING: Economical parking is available at the Civic Center for \$6.00. Public parking is also available for a maximum fee of \$5.00 a day at Republic Parking Garages in three locations: 306 S. Duval, Kleman Plaza, and Downtown at S. Calhoun Street.

RESTAURANTS: The Cafeteria in the Capitol is on the Lower Level (LL). All state newspapers are sold just outside the cafeteria. The Snack Bar is on the 10th Floor of the Capitol. Andrews Capitol Bar and Grill (228 S. Adams Street), Harry's Seafood Bar and Grille (3011 S Bronough Street) and Goodies Eatery (116 E. College Street) also offer a quick lunch.

LOCAL MASS SCHEDULES: Co-Cathedral of St. Thomas More, 900 W. Tennessee St, weekday masses are at 7:00 AM, 5:15 PM. Blessed Sacrament Church, 624 Miccosukee Road, weekday masses are at 8:30 AM and 5:30 PM. There is also 24-hour adoration in the Blessed Sacrament chapel.

LIBRARY: On the 7th floor of the Capitol with historical information, newspapers, etc.

FLORIDA/TALLAHASSEE INFORMATION: On the 1st floor of the Capitol is visitor information by the west entrance. Governor's and Cabinet members' offices are on the 1st floor. The Florida Supreme Court (500 S. Duval St) is across the street from the Capitol west exit by the Visitor Information Center. The Old Capitol faces Monroe St. and Apalachee Parkway.

HOUSE AND SENATE VIEWING GALLERIES: The 5th floor, House (north side), Senate (south side)

ELEVATORS IN CAPITOL: The front elevators serve LL-5. Rear elevators serve floors LL-14 and floors 15-22 (top floor).
